3. Each entrant must complete the entry form in full and pay the required entrance fee. The entrance fee is Rs.150 per photograph; or Rs.100 for students per photograph. Incomplete entry forms may lead to the rejection of the entry at the discretion of the organisers.

4. The entrant permits the organisers to exhibit the entered photograph(s) free of charge at this exhibition only, and indemnifies the organisers, sponsors and anyone associated with this exhibition from loss of or damage to the photograph(s).

5. The exhibition and its organisers, sponsors and associated personnel assume no liability of any misuse of copyright. The onus of any copyright infringement will be the liability of the entrant.

6. Each submitted photograph must be free of any watermark, text or name of the photographer on the front of the photograph.

7. No techniques that add to, relocate, replace, or remove pictorial elements except by cropping are permitted. All adjustments must appear natural.
